

Updates on Programmes for January – February 2016

A. Radio

No.	Date	Items
1.	6 January	Chinese Programme Service produced the annual project “The 38th Top Ten Chinese Gold Songs Awards Presentation Concert” which was the flagship programme of RTHK.
2.	8 – 22 January	R1, R2, R5 and Putonghua Channel (PTC) opened the “Channel Head Hotline” to collect audience’s feedback and comments for review and programme refinements.
3.	11 January	Community Involvement Broadcasting Service (CIBS) premiered its Q11 programmes.
4.	13 – 14 January	R1, R3, and PTC live broadcast the Chief Executive’s (CE) Policy Address. R1 and R3 conducted the “CE’s Phone-in Hotline” on 14 and 15 January respectively.
5.	16 January	Public Affairs Unit produced a special programme for the Taiwan Election.
6.	19 January	R3 organized the “Operation Santa Claus Closing Ceremony”.
7.	21 January	R5 conducted the “MagaSenior – Elderly Road Safety Quiz Competition Final” (香江暖流長者道路安全問答比賽) to reinforce the importance of road safety and enhance the awareness among the elderly.

1.	January	38th Top Ten Chinese Gold Songs Award Presentation Concert (第 38 屆十大中文金曲頒獎音樂會)

6.	January	Ainsley Eats the Street (街頭煮意) (10 episodes x one hour) Street Food is experiencing a revolution, inspiring modern chefs the world over. British celebrity chef Ainsley Harriott travelled to less trodden parts of the globe and the world's backstreets, markets and kitchens to find the world's most exciting Street Food, finding adventure and great cooking along the way. Footprints spanned the Arctic Circle to South East Asia, and from the spice souks of the Middle East to the beaches of the Caribbean.

February	Hong Kong Geographic (山水傳奇) (10 episodes x half hour) A series of 10 documentaries will capture the beauty of Hong Kong countryside and provide knowledge as well as the updated situation of different habitats. The purpose is to draw the awareness of the general public to care about Hong Kong's natural environment.

8.	February	My Family Doctor II (我的家庭醫生 II) (5 episodes x half hour) This is a drama series explaining the concept of family doctor and portraying its importance to every individual and the public health. It also illustrates the positive attitude of family doctors themselves towards their patients and their families.
9.	February	My Dream Factory (我的夢工場) (4 episodes x half hour) The programme will feature persons who work in the film industry, their passion and dream.
10.	February	Sex Education Repack (性本善經典重溫) (30 episodes x one hour) “Sex Education Repack” includes the classic drama series on sex education produced in the past three decades. Karen Lam, the certified sex therapist will be our host. A new short animation will be produced for the frequently asked questions session at the end of each episode.
11.	February	Hong Kong Stories-Metamorphoses (香港故事-變形記) (10 episodes x half hour) Ten widely-known figures will share their experiences in the course of their transformation. How do they swallow their pride in pursuit of their own dreams outside the limelight?
12.	February	Lunar New Year Gathering 2016 [Live] (香港電台靈猴賀豐年新春團拜 [直播]) (1 episode x half hour) RTHK exchanges New Year’s greetings with fellow broadcasters at Broadcasting House. Representatives from Hong Kong’s mass media will also deliver their season’s greetings to the public.
