A. Radio

No.	Date	Items
1.	20 September to 8 November, 17 December	Winning pieces from R3's HK Top Story Competition 2014 were produced for radio broadcast to encourage enrollment. The Prize Presentation Ceremony of 2015 will be held on 17 December.
2.	5 October to 5 November	Chinese Programme Service (CPS) launched the Radio Promotion Campaign 2015 (活·在香港 一同分享) and organized 10 outreaches at shopping malls and universities to promote the RTHK News and MINE mobile apps.

1.	November	2015 DC Election Forum (2015 區議會選舉論壇) (5 episodes x half hour) The District Council Election is going to be held on 22nd November, 2015. RTHK TV Public and Current Affairs Section will organise TV forums for candidates of different districts from 16th to 20th November.
2.	November	Unheard Voices (他們的聲音) (25 episodes x one hour) This is a repackage series of the drama programmes in the 80s and 90s. It aims at recalling our memory of some unheard voices in Hong Kong at that time.
3.	November	Teens Club (青春聯合體) (33 episodes x one hour) Teens Club is a magazine type live program targeted at teenagers. Every episode of Teens Club has segments covering art, science, liberal studies, and economics etc. Teenagers can have fun and knowledge in watching this infotainment programme.

4.	November	<p>Food & Culture IV (味之天下 IV) (10 episodes x half hour)</p> <p>In this season of Food and Culture - The Taste of Hometown, we will be covering a set of stories about food and the lives of their makers in magazine-styled manner with a running theme that focuses on one “hometown taste” for each episode. This season aims at discovering not only the thematic relations between each hometown and the life stories and experience of people, but also new methods of taste explosion over a culinary collaboration between Christian Yang and some home cooks in town.</p>
5.	November	<p>Below The Lion Rock 2015 (獅子山下 2015) (9 episodes x one hour)</p> <p>Hong Kong had experienced drastic economic growth in the 70s, while in the meantime, the native consciousness and self-identity of Hong Kongers had also been radically aroused by the 1967 Riots and the widespread social injustices. The cruelty of the stock market crash in 1987 and the Tiananmen Square protests of 1989 had further created a sense of confusion and instability within the city. Has Hong Kong really moved to a new stage after the handover in 1997? The political reform proposal and the “Occupy Central” movement in 2014 gave us a completely new challenge. No one can neglect the effects and the implications of all these incidents. How can we imprint all these in Below the Lion Rock 2015?</p>
6.	December	<p>Solar Project 2015 (太陽計劃 2015 展翅青見夢飛行) (1 episode x 90 minutes)</p> <p>Long version of the Solar Project concert.</p>
7.	December	<p>The Norden (北國新風情) (6 episodes x half hour)</p> <p>The documentary series "The Norden" takes a closer look at the Nordic welfare model and the Nordic society, from an outsider's point of view.</p>
8.	December	<p>Artspiration (好想藝術) (12 episodes x half hour)</p> <p>Artspiration, an arts and cultural television programme, returned for a new season. It continued to bring arts knowledge and anecdotes in its signature light-hearted and humorous approach to audiences and show that art is everywhere; art is a soul-searching process; art is sharing.</p>
9.	December	<p>Who am I (我係乜乜乜) (7 episodes x half hour)</p> <p>To address and question the social situations in nowadays Hong Kong in lively format. To explore and examine what constitutes to labelling and bias that has split Hong Kong society in these years.</p>
