

**Updates on Programmes for  
September – October 2017**

**A. Radio**

No.	Date	Items
1.	2 September	A special series of “Gold Songs 40 You and Me (金曲 40 我和你)” was premiered as a prologue to celebrate the 40 <sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Top Ten Chinese Gold Songs Award. A total of forty 3-minute videos were also produced and disseminated through TV31, RTHK MINE and Facebook etc.
2.	3 / 4 September	<p>In view of the discontinuation of Digital Audio Broadcasting (DAB) services from 12 midnight of 3 September, new programming arrangement was launched on 4 September to continue catering for the underprivileged, ethnic minorities and different communities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) A total of 16 hours of Community Involvement Broadcasting Service (CIBS) programmes are broadcast daily on Putonghua Channel (PTC);</li> <li>b) The Putonghua version of the programme “Audio Book (有聲好書)” is broadcast on PTC while the Cantonese version was broadcast on Radio 1 (R1);</li> <li>c) The programme “Sound of Nature (大自然之聲)” is broadcast on R1;</li> <li>d) The programme “Audio Art (光影無限 Like)” will be broadcast on the first Sunday of every month from October onwards on Radio 5 (R5);</li> <li>e) BBC World Service is relayed from 2300 to 0700 daily on Radio 4 (R4);</li> <li>f) China National Radio Hong Kong Edition is relayed on Radio 6 (R6); and</li> <li>g) Legislative Council meetings will continue to be relayed on TV32, RTHK website and the mobile application “Screen”.</li> </ul>
3.	7 / 23 September	Two new programmes produced by the Cultural and Education Unit (CEU) were launched in September. “All about Food (考飲考食)” is broadcast on R5 to introduce the historical development and cultural origin of food. “Talk of the World (打開世界)” was premiered on R2 to share different cultural aspects in various places along the Belt and Road.

No.	Date	Items
4.	10 / 28 September	R1 conducted the “Occupational Safety and Health Quiz Show 2017 (職安健常識問答比賽 2017)” in early September to strengthen the public awareness of occupational safety. Another activity “Happy Daily Fire Services Community Day (開心日報消防周記同樂日)” was arranged in late September to visit the Tseung Kwan O Fire Services Training School with the audience.
5.	11 September	Radio on TV “Healthpedia (精靈一點)” was simulcast from 1300 to 1400 on R1 and TV31, starting from 11 September.
6.	16-17 September / 7 / 9 October	Interviews for Q19 and Q20 programmes of CIBS were held in mid-September. A Facilitation Talk for the applicants will be arranged in early October. The new programmes of Q18 will be premiered on 9 October with the theme of religion and philosophy.
7.	18 September	R3 launched the annual English writing competition Hong Kong Top Story 2017 in September. Applicants were asked to write stories about a picture from a Hong Kong renowned photographer Ho Fan.
8.	18 September – 13 October	DAB started the preliminary selection of “Audio Book Best Voice Competition 2018 (有聲好書全港中學生聲演比賽 2018)” in mid-September. A total of 20 schools joined the contest, including 2 special schools and 2 schools with ethnic minorities.
9.	21 September	A new round of promotion “Power of Voice (聲音的力量)” was organized for the special series of “Audio Art – Ann Hui Series (光影無限 Like –許鞍華系列)” and “Audio Book – Literary Classic Series (有聲好書- 經典文學系列)”.
10.	29 September	R2’s TeenPower, co-organized with Occupational Safety & Health Council, will launch “OSH Power Up 2017-18 – Occupational Safety GIF Animation Design Competition (職安 Power 全起動–職安健 GIF 動畫設計比賽啟動禮)” to stimulate the creativity of young people.
11.	7 October	PAU, organized jointly with the Hong Kong Red Cross, will announce the “10 <sup>th</sup> Hong Kong Humanity Award (香港人道年獎)” which is the very first award of its kind in Hong Kong since 2007.
12.	15 October	PTC will conduct the “20 Most Beloved Golden Oldies (摯愛 20 真經典)” presentation ceremony to announce the most favoured oldies elected by the public.
13.	17 October	R5 will coordinate “Stand by Me Star Parents Scheme 2016-17 – Workshop (有你同行升級家長計劃 2016-18 – 家長體驗日)” to enhance parent-children relationship and deliver anti-drug messages in families.

## B. TV Programmes

No.	Date	Items
1.	3 September	TV Division live transmitted on TV32 and provided pool feed signal to the media for “The Ceremony to Commemorate The Victory Day of the Chinese People's War of Resistance against Japanese Aggression (中國人民抗日戰爭勝利紀念日儀式)” on 3 September.
2.	8 September	“International Gala Extraordinaire – Stage of Ability 2017 (能者舞台非凡夜 2017)” was held on 8 September at Queen Elizabeth Stadium, with a multi-media virtual reality exhibition before the show. The show was also broadcast on TV 31 and 31A.
3.	Starting 9 September	A new band of news in brief, “19:00 新聞簡報”, was slotted at 1900-1905 daily.
4.	9, 16 & 23 September & 28 October	3 performances by world renowned artistes and 1 Chinese Orchestral performance were scheduled for broadcast in September and October: “John Wilson at the BBC Proms – Tribute to Leonard Bernstein (伯恩斯坦樂滿百老匯)” on 9 September, “Salzburg Festival 2016: Yuja Wang and the Camerata Salzburg (王羽佳飛躍薩爾斯堡)” on 16 September, “2Cellos – Score... And More - Live At The Sydney Opera House (提琴雙傑 - 悉尼歌劇院演奏會)” on 23 September and “L'Amour Immortel (倩女幽魂)” on 28 October.
5.	Starting 11 September	By conducting sophisticated tests and experiments, the documentary “Born Naughty? (天生百厭星?)” (4 episodes x 60 minutes): attempted to study and diagnose children's anti-social behaviour.
6.	Starting 12 September	“Soundtracks – Songs that Defined History (歲月迴聲)” (8 episodes x 60 minutes) explored the music that have been tied to iconic moments in history.
7.	Starting 12 September	“Sports for all (全民動起來)” (13 episodes x 30 minutes) is a reality show programme, which invited sports elite to teach the general public different kinds of sports.
8.	13 September	“Civil Service Outstanding Service Award 2017 (傑出部門群英會 2017)” (2 episodes x 30 minutes) featured outstanding services of different government departments.
9.	Starting 24 September	“Everyday Design (設計日常)” (8 episodes x 30 minutes) introduced local design details in everyday life.
10.	1 October	To celebration the National Day on 1 October, TV Division will cover and live transmit on TV 32 the Flag-raising Ceremony cum Reception as well as provide pool feel signal to other media.

11.	Starting 1 October	“Our Scientists (我們的科學家)” (5 episodes x 60 minutes) will feature 5 renowned scientists and demonstrate their remarkable scientific achievements, including Professor Dennis LO (盧煜明教授), Professor Joseph LEE (李行偉教授), Professor LAM Hon-ming (林漢明教授), Professor Nancy IP (葉玉如教授), Professor Sun KWOK (郭新教授) and Professor CHE Chi-ming (支志明教授).
12.	11-13 October	CE’S Policy Address and related events will be live transmitted on TV32.
13.	14 October	Collaborated with CreateHK and Hong Kong Fashion Designers Association, “Juxtaposed Fashion x Music 2017 (對比 時裝 X 音樂)” (1 episode x 90 minutes) aims to demonstrate local fashion designers’ talent.
14.	21 October	TV Division will cover and live transmit on TV32 the “Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People’s Republic of China Honours and Awards Presentation Ceremony 2017 (二〇一七年度勳銜頒授典禮)” as well as provide pool feed signal to other media.
15.	21 October	“Our Hong Kong Young Notes (青年音韻樂悠揚)”, a classical music performance featuring young talents, will be staged on 21 October and broadcast on 12 November 2017.

### C. New Media Unit

No.	Date	Items
1.	4 September	With the termination of DAB service, modifications were made on RTHK website and the apps, including RTHK On The Go, RTHK Mine, and an opt-out of RTHK Cube from the app stores.
2.	Early September	Thematic contents of “金曲40我和你” were added to enrich the special website of the 40 <sup>th</sup> anniversary of Top Ten Chinese Gold Songs Award which was launched on 18 August.
3.	September - October	Multi-platform promotions of RTHK new media contents, including bus shelter poster, web and social media, video promotion on RTHK 31, and radio trailer publicity were scheduled for this period.
4.	September – October	The special online projects of “中華文化頻道” and “精選廣播劇” will be revamped to enhance content and design accessibility on latest browsers.
5.	October	Enhancements on the archive search and technical refinements on rthk.hk were scheduled for October.
